	<i>Sicily, Italy</i> Made from local Sicilian grape varieties, this great wine is light bodied yet full of ripe fresh fruit flavour.

	<i>South Eastern, Australia</i> A soft buttery Chardonnay, with a smooth mouthfeel and a rich fruity finish. Whilst this wine makes an excellent companion to most types of food it is mellow enough to also be enjoyed on its own.

	<i>Marlborough, New Zealand</i> Tropical citrus fruit aromas lead to a palate which bursts with lemongrass and limes.

	<i>Alsace, France</i> Pale lemon in colour with soft green hues and an open floral nose. Full bodied lemony citrus characters, fresh and enticing with good length.

	<i>Burgundy, France</i> This is a lively and fresh Chablis with clean citrus aromas. Crisp and fruity on the palate with a good steely character. The finish is long and lean, perfect for accompanying meaty white fish.
